CONCHACER secured terms with several rivals on the pace while caught five wide in the opening quarter, continued with a steady bid racing four deep on the turn, moved to wrest command when given his cue in upper stretch and drew well clear while being shown a right handed whip. ROARIN MISSILE, held up just off the first flight while angling inwards in the opening stages, moved to challenge inside the leaders nearing the furlong marker, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. HOLD THAT BROAD moved to the fore from the outset, dictated the pace racing well off the inside into the bend but gave out once headed approaching the furlong marker. HOLIDAY BALLAD tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside racing to the bend, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. DEMIGOD, a bit outpaced in early stages, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked a serious rally. MIGHTY RULE broke outwards brushing HYRDO POWER, was urged to secure a forward placing along the rail racing to the turn but faded from contention early. HYDRO POWER, brushed at the start, was quickly righted to track just off the first flight between foes in the opening stages but quickly dropped out of contention entering the turn.
