BEWARE THE TIGER grabbed the lead, pulled away into the stretch, drifted out late under right-handed pressure and was all out. OFFICER MCNEAL outrun early, moved four wide into the stretch, closed ground and was steadied in the final strides. DEVIANT BEHAVIOR outpaced while five wide, took a bad step at the five-eighths marker and was outfinished. IRON CHAMP never menaced. BEENIE was always outrun. BOURBON TRAIL saved ground and had no rally. GOTTA BELIEVE ME chased the pace while four wide and tired. PRAIRIE BREEZE stalked the pace and weakened.
