Footnotes

YANKEE ROBIN broke sharply to establish a clear advantage while angling quickly to the inside, dictated the pace on her own courage maintaining a substantial advantage on the turn, forged clear racing into upper stretch and widened the margin late under pressure. WHERE'S WANDA, urged along four wide in the second flight in pursuit of the pacesetter, angled nearer to the inside gaining a clear second racing into upper stretch but couldn't menace the winner. FOXIE'S BEAUTY, urged to contend between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, weakened after a half. MONGOLIAN FRONT tracked the pacesetter three deep between foes in the second flight early but faded nearing upper stretch. TAVA'S PRIZE was held up off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to advance racing three deep into the turn but never gained striking distance. NOWTHATSALADY broke slowly, was urged to gain contention, steadied off rivals nearing the half mile marker and never gained striking position. MAGDALENKA was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but dropped out early.
