Footnotes

STORMIN WILDCAT, unhurried in the opening stages while steadily gaining terms with the first flight five deep, continued with a steady effort attending the leader's pace while racing just outside that foe on the bend, asserted himself in upper stretch to wrest command leaving the furlong marker and drew away late under firm handling. THIEF, held up off the second flight in the opening stages, split foes near the inside racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. WEBSTER moved to secure the lead from between foes early, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside into upper stretch but weakened once headed by the winner. BLACK CROSS, pulling a bit tracking the pacesetter along the rail racing into the bend, lacked the needed final bid. WINNING WILDCAT hopped at the start, then was bumped by HOLY BULLHIVE, settled off the second flight racing to the bend, angled out five wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. HOLY BULLHIVE broke inwards bumping a rival, was urged along four, then three wide between foes chasing the leaders but steadily faded racing into the stretch. GRATTAN STREET, urged to contend between foes in the opening stages, dropped off the first flight after the opening quarter and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. HUCKLEBERRY BOY never a factor.
