P D Q KIDDO bobbled at the start while breaking last, was guided to the rail in the opening furlong, made steady progress inside foes racing into the far turn to gain contention, shifted out in upper stretch to bid for command between foes leaving the furlong marker and narrowly prevailed in the final stages under firm left handed encouragement. FRANCOIS, caught four wide racing into the first turn while taking up a position in the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch while steadily drawing into striking range, shifted inwards in the closing stages while moving to challenge in tandem with the winner but was outfinished. HOPE FOR TODAY, urged to gain terms with the pacesetter racing into the first turn, stalked that foe to the second bend, moved to challenge racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker but couldn't quite fend off the top pair late. BIG LOOIE was urged to dictate the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, dueled for command leaving the far turn and gave way midstretch. FOUR LEFT FEET tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight early, shifted out entering the backstretch, was urged to advance three deep on the far turn but soon faded from contention. FAST ALEX, brushed at the start, was settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. TRAC N JAM tracked the leaders unhurried from out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half and never mounted a serious challenge. CHEROKEE LORD, urged to contend three deep between foes racing into the first turn, faded early. THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
