Footnotes

GOHOMEBAY was hustled clear along the rail racing into the first turn to open a commanding margin after the opening quarter, set the pace into the far turn and gamely held the challenge of KIPSON to the end under pressure. The latter was guided to the inside early to track just off the second flight, made a steady advance to striking distance inside foes racing into the stretch and shifted outside the pacesetter while closing the gap in the final strides. LOMBARDI TIME settled well off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the second bend, then split foes three deep while making steady progress late. BETWEEN DREAMS tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight racing to the far turn and continued evenly between foes in that path racing into the stretch. SUN TIME was urged to gain a forward placing while ceding the lead to the eventual winner racing into the first turn, made steady progress to challenge that foe racing into upper stretch but drifted late while failing to gain terms with that foe. RUNAWAY CAL, bumped at the start, tracked the pace between foes off the second flight in the opening half, lodged a brief bid between foes on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. SOMEWHERE IN TIME settled along the inside for six furlongs, shifted out six wide entering the stretch but lacked the needed final kick. CLASSIC RECITAL settled outside a rival in the last flight early and never gained contention. NO TIME TO KID (IRE) showed little. JETAMENO was settled along the

rail in early stages, shifted out midway through the backstretch and never seriously menaced. BALLISTIC TIM, caught wide to the backstretch, faded from contention early.
