PROUD JACKSON gained terms with several rivals on the pace racing in the four path while three deep between foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path through the turn to upper stretch, edged forward to a narrow advantage approaching the furlong marker and drove clear. MIDWAY IN was urged to the lead from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing off the rail through the backstretch, shifted inwards entering the bend, dueled for command inside foes into upper stretch and proved best of the others. PRESTON CAN, in touch with the first flight five deep in the opening stages, maintained striking distance racing four wide on the turn to upper stretch but weakened in the last furlong while continuing well enough to earn a share. QUIET REBEL was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, dueled for command to upper stretch and gave way. CHAMPAGNEBYTHESEA tracked the first flight from out of striking distance along the inside racing into the turn and continued evenly into upper stretch. MANET settled between foes in the opening stages, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. ROCKIN MAGIC broke slowly, then was bumped at the start, shifted immediately to the rail, made some progress to gain position inside foes racing into the stretch but had no final response. PISTOL PERSUASION hopped at the start, settled well off the pace, was urged to gain some position racing three wide between foes on the turn but lacked the

needed final bid. SILVER ADDED broke outwards bumping ROCKIN MAGIC, was collected to track between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. HE'S BORN TO RUN raced unhurried along the rail in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. FASTER N GRACIE tracked off the first flight six wide in the opening quarter, continued widest into the turn and steadily faded from contention.
