Footnotes

DENHAM tracked the leaders from within striking distance along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch, continued with a steady effort to advance three deep on the leaders nearing the second bend, wrested command midway through the far turn and held sway to the end under firm handling. DON'T BLUFF was settled outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out four wide on the backstretch while moving to contention, then continued with a steady bid outside the winner to prove best of the others while failing to gain terms with that foe. ALL IN SLEW, in touch with the leaders between foes racing to the first turn, was eased off the pace nearing the backstretch to track the leaders a bit off the inside, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. HE'S BONAFIDE bobbed slightly at the break, recovered to join the pace outside foes racing three deep into the first turn, continued to press the issue between foes into the second bend but steadily weakened when failing to match the winner entering upper stretch. MAGIC BULLET settled into stride along the inside early but never gained contention. ELECTRIC ALPHABET tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch and steadily faded entering the far turn. CHAMPION KID was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, set the pace for a half on a narrow margin and emptied out once headed entering the far turn.
