Footnotes

MILES AND MILES was rated between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes to race four wide into the second bend, then continued with a steady advance in that path to challenge for command nearing midstretch and edged forward late under firm encouragement. DADDYSPENTDAMONEY tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep nearing the far turn, struck the front near midstretch but couldn't contain the winner late. LEAD THE WAY settled in the last flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out on

the far turn gradually gaining contention, then angled five wide entering the stretch while continuing with interest to prevail for a share. POPLAR HOUSE tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention between foes on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch to challenge between foes but was outkicked in the final stages. HIGH SPIRIT settled outside foes four wide racing to the backstretch, was fanned six wide into the stretch but made some mild progress to gain position late. LIMESTONE settled between foes in the last flight early, angled out five wide nearing upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. HURTA ,forwardly placed in the opening stages, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, moved to challenge on the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. THIRD RAIL settled three deep between foes in the opening stages and offered no rally. KERA'S KITTEN, forwardly placed along the inside tracking the pacesetter in second flight for a half, steadily faded racing into the far turn. ENEMY FIRE was urged to secure the lead between foes racing into the first turn, set the pace to the second bend and emptied out abruptly once headed entering the second bend.
