CONGA saved ground through the turn, angled out in the stretch and closed with a rush. THANKS LORD chased the pace, contended to the turn and was set down for the long drive and was caught late. MISS SILVERSIDES settled early and saved ground then rallied through traffic but was outfinished. NO IMAGE stalked the leader, led briefly in the turn, made a bid and flattened out. ADACAT raced close up between horses, battled to the half and came up empty. LUCKY LIBBY set a pressured pace then gave way inside. NO WORSE FOR WEAR was allowed to settle, was hung out six wide in the turn and faltered. QUEEN STELL raced close up early, was five wide in the turn and stopped.
