B N GRACED N GLORY moved to the fore racing to the first turn, dictated the pace in hand a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, edged clear midway through the far turn while remaining off the rail and held sway on a open margin to the end under firm handling. SARAROYAL angled inwards in the opening stages while being reserved just out of striking distance, shifted out three deep on the far turn while being urged to advance, couldn't gain terms with the winner but held a rival for place honors. DUBIOUS, reserved saving ground in the opening half, swung out four wide racing through the far turn, continued widest into upper stretch but finished willingly to close the gap while missing for second. PROUD OSCEOLA, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, shifted out racing through the far turn and improved her position three deep between foes. FIRST OF FEBRUARY, in touch with the pacesetter in the opening stages, attended that rival's pace under light rating to the backstretch, was urged to maintain that position racing through the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. HURRICANE KATIE tracked the leaders outside foes from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, shifted to the inside on the far turn and offered no closing response. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN, urged to secure a forward placing three deep racing to the backstretch, emptied out racing through the far turn.
