TATY'S GOLD was hustled to the lead soon after the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin a bit off the inside racing to upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. MISS TWENTY ONE tracked the pacesetter near the inside racing as part of the second flight into the turn, shifted out sharply leaving midstretch while being urged to challenge the winner but couldn't gain terms with her rival. MAUDE S settled into stride near the inside racing as part of the last flight early, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes, then angled to the rail in late stages while narrowly edging a rival for a share. MAHOGANY STORM led the second flight racing well off the inside into the turn, briefly moved to challenge the pacesetter after a half but had no closing bid. SACRED HONOR tracked the leader four deep between foes in the second flight racing into the turn and continued evenly in that path into the stretch. A SHOT AWAY was settled between foes in the last flight early and never gained striking distance. ART OF SURVIVAL, caught five wide tracking just off the second flight racing into the turn, made some brief progress to gain position outside foes racing into upper stretch but came up empty leaving the furlong marker. MY MY MY MARIA was guided to the rail early tracking the pace in second flight, saved ground on the turn but steadily faded from contention. HARBORTON, reserved off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, soon dropped out.
