Footnotes

JUDY'S QUEST, reserved in last while racing off the inside in the opening stages, continued under patient handling awaiting an opening midway through the turn, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and produced a sustained response in the last furlong to just edge OFFICER PHILLY under firm left handed pressure. The latter was held up along the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out nearing midstretch to bid for command between foes and just missed. TESSIES TILBURY moved to the fore soon after the break, dictated the pace off the inside on the backstretch, angled to the rail racing through the turn, resisted grudgingly when challenged but just failed to contain the top pair. SHES GOT TO RUN tracked off the second flight three deep between rivals, advanced in that path to challenge nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MISSY BISCUIT, held up between foes tracking just off the second flight racing to the bend, continued evenly between rivals into the stretch. BABA BOOYAH, urged along three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the turn, briefly challenged the leader leaving the turn but weakened leaving midstretch. SHAKALEENA settled outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the turn and lacked a rally. QUEEN OF SCIOTO settled off the second flight along the rail in early stages, saved ground on the turn but offered no rally. HIGH BROW HONEY was a brief factor between foes tracking the pacesetter in second flight but steadily retreated racing into the stretch.
