Footnotes

SPORTING GENT was rated between foes just off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out three deep entering the turn commencing a steady advance, moved to challenge for command in that path nearing midstretch and edged forward in time under firm handling. NO MO MOE came through close quarters at the start to track the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, moved to challenge racing into upper stretch, was caught in tight quarters nearing the furlong marker while disputing the issue between foes and proved only second best. RAZZO SUCCO broke inwards bumping HOMES THE FACT, was collected while dropping well off the pace, worked his way to the inside racing into the turn and made steady progress inside foes in late stages while prevailing for a share. BAILOUT BUDDY tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady effort to improve position to the end. WINDY CITY RICHIE, bumped at the start, sped to the fore despite his rider's momentary loss of his irons, set the pace to upper stretch but emptied out once headed near the furlong marker. TWO LIONS settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. SEASCAPE was a brief factor three deep in the second flight racing to the turn and steadily faded into upper stretch. EIGHTEEN WHEELS was urged along chasing the pacesetter inside foes racing into the turn and steadily retreated while shifting off the inside racing into upper stretch. HOMES THE FACT, bumped at the start and forced into WINDY CITY RICHIE, lost his rider, then walked off the course under his own power after the race. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
