Footnotes

BROKEN AERO was rated along the inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, came around a stricken foe after a half while continuing under patient handling, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted out to split foes just off the inside challenging for command and just edged **DANCING ROCK** in time under firm right handed encouragement. The latter went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival into the backstretch, shook clear racing through the far turn and resisted the winner's bid grudgingly to the end. **MEC DANCER** shifted off the inside early to track the pace off the second flight, moved to challenge four wide racing through the far turn and continued willingly in that path to late stages to close the gap while prevailing for a share. **PESO** tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, was urged to advance three deep between foes racing through the far turn, moved to challenge between foes in that path through the lane but was outkicked. **FRANKLIN COUNTY** settled between foes off the second flight while shifting a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, altered course to the four path avoiding a stricken foe midway through the backstretch, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to improve his placing. **KLIPIT** settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress between foes late. **DOMAIN'S RAP** settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and passed some tiring rivals in the drive. **KING ROOTIN TOOTIN**, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, steadied a bit when passing a stricken foe midway through the backstretch and offered no rally. **PIRALU** was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the first turn, couldn't match that foe after a half and steadily retreated racing into the stretch. **TAKE A CHANCE** was urged to secure a forward

placing tracking just off the first flight, was pulled up abruptly after a half, then was vanned off the course.
