Footnotes

FEISTY LOVE was rated outside foes in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, raced five wide into the bend commencing a steady advance, wrested command while shifting inwards racing into upper stretch, ducked inwards a bit while throwing her head near midstretch but continued with a solid late response to draw well clear under pressure. SPECIALAGENTNCHARG settled off the second flight six wide in the opening quarter, made steady progress racing four wide through the bend to gain position outside foes and continued with interest into the stretch to prove best of the others. AULT STREET settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out racing through the turn and continued with an effort to improve position while earning a share. ARGUE THE TOSS was rated between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, moved to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. LADY ON THE MOVE tracked off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, was urged to challenge four wide between foes racing into the turn but emptied out leaving midstretch when failing to match the winner. NAJCAT tracked just off the first flight along the rail

racing into the turn, shifted outside a tiring foe entering the bend but offered no closing response. TRIMBLE CREEK was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset racing into the turn and gave way after a half. BUCKLE UP OUTLAW settled between foes in the opening stages and offered no rally. SONORI'S PRIDE broke inwards bumping IRON ROSE, was righted to press the pace three wide racing into the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. IRON ROSE, bumped, then shuffled back at the start, never gained contention. CHESTNUT SOUP was urged to dispute the pace inside foes in the opening quarter but emptied out early.
