Footnotes

SPY HUNTER was settled out of striking distance outside foes in the opening half, continued unhurried to the second bend, made steady progress on the far turn while shifting outside foes, angled eight wide in upper stretch while moving to striking distance and edged SHELLOWEE in the final stages under firm encouragement. The latter settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the backstretch, commenced a steady advance while shifting out on the far turn, split foes six wide racing into upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker, resisted the winner's challenge but came up second best. PALO DURO CANYON, pulling a bit under rating in the opening stages, tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, continued in hand while awaiting an opening leaving the far turn, came through when presented an opening in upper stretch to challenge between foes, continued inside foes while racing in close quarters leaving the furlong marker and secured a share. FIRE CLOUD broke inwards bumping a rival, secured a forward placing racing four wide in the opening stages, advanced in that path to challenge leaving the far turn but lacked the needed final response. GAGE PARK, reserved three deep racing in second flight in the opening half, made steady progress nearing the far turn to bid between foes nearing upper stretch, was carried out by DUNNOTARR in upper stretch and quickly gave way. SMARTY MOUTH stumbled at the start, settled into stride, made steady progress just off the inside on the far turn to regain contention, was steadied when blocked approaching the furlong marker and had no further response. STAR OF PARADISE tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, shifted out in search of an opening racing through the far turn, altered course back to the inside in upper stretch to split foes three deep, was shut off in traffic and steadied out of tight quarters leaving the furlong marker to quickly lose contention. DUNNOTARR was urged to a forward placing in the opening quarter, joined the pace outside a rival after a half, duelled for command between foes into the far turn, ducked out leaving the three sixteenths marker impeding GAGE PARK and quickly dropped out. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN broke slowly, was bumped by FIRE

CLOUD, settled off the inside early, made a brief bid racing seven wide into upper stretch but had no final kick. SEGURO tracked just off the leaders along the inside in second flight, raced in close quarters on the second bend, then quickly retreated when losing his path in upper stretch. DEVILS TOWER tracked off the second flight outside rivals, shifted out making brief progress five deep on the second bend but proved empty in the drive. UNO PECADOR was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
