Footnotes

ZIMANY joined the pace between foes soon after the break, moved to press the issue outside a rival racing into upper stretch, went clear nearing the furlong marker and just maintained his advantage under steady handling. RENO RIDGE, forwardly placed inside foes in the opening stages, lost some position despite some pressure racing through the turn, shifted out three deep racing through the stretch and found his best response in the final sixteenth to just miss. NO PASSAGE broke slowly, then was bumped by SPEND WILDY while forced into the path of INEXCESSIVE SUE at the break, saved ground on the bend while gradually gaining contention, then came through tight quarters nearing the furlong marker to dispute the issue willingly to the end while just outkicked by the top pair. INEXCESSIVE SUE, bumped at the start, raced under some reserve between foes, shifted in to save ground on the turn, switched out nearing the furlong marker while producing a strong late response and was going well late. SHANE'S SPIRIT, forwardly placed four wide in the opening

stages, advanced in that path to make a brief bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. FEAR NOR FAVOR tracked off the first flight five deep early, continued in that path into upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. SHARP ROMA broke sharply, dueled for command along the inside, gained a narrow advantage on the turn but emptied out leaving midstretch when failing to match terms with the winner. SCHAEFER, caught wide throughout, proved no factor. SPEND WILDLY broke outwards bumping NO PASSAGE, was quickly righted to join the pace three wide racing into the turn and gave way after a half. KATHY'S MAN broke outwards exchanging contact with COELLA, lost position to the field and never menaced thereafter. COELLA, unruly in the gate before the start, broke inwards bumping a rival and retreated from contention early. LIKELY'S SUM trailed.
