COYOTE BREEZE, urged along five wide tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, gradually drew into striking distance in that path entering upper stretch, continued with a steady effort to wrest command and drive clear. MS MANANA, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter just off the inside, pressed between foes to upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. THUNDERING HOOFS tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing into the turn, bid between foes racing into the stretch and edged a rival for a share. SLIGO BREEZE angled inside tracking off the second flight in the opening stages and made an effort to improve position late. THRILL MAKER, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, gave way once headed leaving midstretch. LA TIA tracked just off the leaders four wide racing into the turn, made a brief bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. SKY KIP broke awkwardly and trailed throughout.
