ELK RAPIDS NATIVE took up a tracking position racing under some reserve off the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress three wide advancing on the leaders on the far turn, moved to wrest command near midstretch and drew away under firm encouragement. BLUE CANOE tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in that path to upper stretch making steady progress, couldn't match terms with the winner but prevailed in late stages for the place. JINGLE JANGLE, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and made some belated progress while angling to the outside late. MISTER BENTLEY, forwardly placed from the outset, tracked just off the first flight under some reserve racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge the leader on the far turn, led between calls in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. CHOCTAW SMOKE broke awkwardly, was settled off the inside in the opening half, angled out six wide racing through the stretch and made an effort to improve position. SPICY JACK tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside racing to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. PERFECT TRIP tracked the leaders unhurried off the second flight into the backstretch but couldn't muster a rally. CHIEF CHICAGO was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but was through after a half. FLASH JORDAN was urged to join the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, edged

forward to a clear advantage on the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. SMOKY STORM tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside from off the second flight to the backstretch and lacked the needed late response. RUN OR PASS bobbed, then was shut off at the start and never menaced thereafter. TRIPLE OVERTIME broke sharply, was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way after five furlongs.
