**Footnotes**

WILDCAT GAMBLE settled off the second flight in the opening stages racing outside rivals, made steady progress four wide on the bend to gain striking distance in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and went clear under firm left handed pressure. COLE B tracked the pacesetter five deep in the second flight in the opening stages, angled inwards entering the bend advancing readily on the leader, pressed the issue to gain brief command between calls in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. CELTIC EXPRESS was urged along to contention inside foes in the second flight, couldn't gain terms with the top pair but continued willingly to the end to gain a share. GOLD DE LAC settled outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned six wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress. DURANTS AFLEET broke outwards, bumped JAGUAR CRAFTY, settled into stride, was fanned seven wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. WINE CLASSIC, urged to a forward placing, tracked the leaders between foes racing into the bend and faded late. BARLIV tracked the pace unhurried between foes just off the second flight early and continued evenly into the stretch. LET'S POP THE CORK was urged to the lead while angling inside, dueled for command along the rail on the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. JAGUAR CRAFTY, bumped at the start, was settled off the inside, then came around some tiring rivals in late stages. PROUD ATHLETE settled near the inside early, angled out in upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. AFFAIR INTHE WOODS dropped out of contention early. SMART REALITY was a brief factor between foes but was through after a half.
