Footnotes

LADIES DRINK FREE, urged to secure a position just off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, continued with a steady advance in that path on the bend to challenge entering upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure leaving the furlong marker brushing CAUSEGOOD but edged forward of that foe in time under firm handling. CAUSEGOOD broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, gained a clear advantage after three furlongs while remaining off the inside, held sway into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to late stages but yielded after being brushed by that rival late. MARKREE BREEZE tracked the leaders near the inside in second flight racing to the bend, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while making steady progress and continued willingly outside the top pair to close the gap while earning a share. LEWDERHOO tracked off the second flight along the inside early, shifted a bit off the inside nearing upper stretch while drawing into striking distance but lacked the needed final response. TYDRO, bumped at the start by PRINCIPALIA, was steadied off that rival at the start, settled between foes racing to the turn, then steadily improved her position between foes racing through the stretch with a belated response. BROOKE'S JOURNEY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, was caught five wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded in the last quarter. PRINCIPALIA broke inwards bumping TYDRO, was settled between foes and never gained contention. CAMP COOK tracked off the second flight off the inside racing into the bend but couldn't produce a closing bid. BREEZE OF LIBERTY broke slowly and never mounted a serious challenge. LADY LUA, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, emptied out after three furlongs. THEBIBLELLSMESO, a bit reluctant to load in the gate, trailed throughout.
