### Footnotes

SCARLETRY, held up between foes in the second flight while pulling hard under restraint racing into the first turn, continued under a pull while shifting out four deep entering the second bend, steadily moved to terms with the first flight in that path on the far turn, was roused to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch and held sway to the end on a widening margin under firm encouragement. NAYLA'S IMAGE tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight under reserve racing to the far turn, came through inside foes entering upper stretch to challenge but proved only second best. RAILLERY, urged to secure a position just off the pacesetter racing to the first turn, was reserved off the leaders entering the backstretch to race between foes in the second flight, continued under reserve into the second bend, split foes four deep nearing midstretch and made an effort to improve position. NANCY'S RAP, urged to a contending position three deep racing just off the pacesetter, shifted inwards on the backstretch attending that rival's pace between foes, pressed the issue on the far turn into upper stretch and gave way. CAMP FAIRFAX R N tracked the pace outside foes in second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily advanced on the leaders three deep nearing the far turn, bid for command between foes in that path racing through the far turn and emptied out in upper stretch. INDIAN ICON, urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. ROSE PRINCESS was settled off the second flight while switching off the inside in the opening stages, raced widest throughout and never seriously menaced.
