Footnotes

ALL STORMY, caught four wide racing to the backstretch while racing unhurried well off the second flight, commenced a steady advance outside foes entering the second bend to challenge three deep for command nearing upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm handling. REAL POWER, reserved near the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress splitting foes after a half advancing to contention, moved to challenge between foes after six furlongs just inside the eventual winner, resisted that rival's challenge while shifting to the inside in upper stretch but came up second best. HERE COMES MARIO stumbled at the start, settled collecting his stride racing to the backstretch, made some progress while angling out five wide racing into upper stretch and improved his placing while earning a share. SUNNY FITZ settled in last racing to the far turn, then passed some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. INDIAN SUOVENIR, urged to a forward placing racing to the first turn, tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight, moved to gain brief command racing into the far turn but emptied out once headed by the top pair. BRIM tracked the pace unhurried three deep between foes racing to the backstretch and lacked a closing response. SWEET CRUDE tracked off the second flight while shifting out three wide nearing the far turn and steadily faded. CHAS THE MAN broke sharply, was urged to gain a clear advantage near the inside racing to the backstretch, ceded the lead to a rival entering the second bend, was urged to briefly challenge between foes on the second bend but quickly gave way. BOOGIE MAN JOE, urged to secure a forward placing along the inside, was spent after a half.
