**Footnotes**

COURTLY was settled outside a rival racing well out of striking distance in the opening half, commenced a steady advance shifting out four wide entering the second bend, circled foes racing into upper stretch to challenge for command, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under firm right handed encouragement. BEWARE THE TIGER, prominent between foes racing into the first turn, continued just off the pacesetter after ceding the lead entering the backstretch, moved to challenge three deep on the far turn, struck the front after six furlongs, couldn't fend off the winner but proved best of the others. IKAROS settled well off the field racing to the second bend, swung out six wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress while earning a share. CATHYS BREEZE, bumped at the start, angled to the rail tracking the pace off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out four wide

racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. MERCEDES CLASS, on terms with the first flight in the opening stages, was eased just off the leaders to track the pace near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering the second bend while being urged to challenge between foes, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. ONE FOR BISCUIT, urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the first turn, lost some position to the pacesetter after the opening quarter and gave way racing into the far turn. GAVILAN tracked off the first flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out while making a brief bid racing into the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. CLOUD CASTLE was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. MISTER THAYER, urged to join the pace five wide racing into the first turn, gained brief command entering the backstretch while shifting to the inside and emptied out after six furlongs. HERE COMES HENRY broke outwards bumping CATHYS BREEZE, was hustled four deep between foes to join the pace racing into the first turn, steadied a bit of out close quarters racing to the backstretch and was spent early.
