### Footnotes

PETERS ROCK broke sharply to establish a clear advantage, set the pace along the inside racing into the turn, turned back a challenge from ALL TANKED UP racing through upper stretch and edged forward late under firm handling. The latter gained a forward placing tracking just off the leader racing to the turn, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch but was only second best. STIG'S DEPUTY tracked just off the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch while being roused to advance inside foes but finished evenly in late stages. CALL M'EV'E MAYBE shifted out three wide early tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. ARTFUL BEE bobbled at the start, was righted to track the leaders along the inside from out of striking distance racing into the bend, angled five wide acing through upper stretch but made no real impression. MYSTIC stumbled at the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter.
