PRAIRIE JIN rallied mildly for a share while no threat to the top two. SEA MISSION bore out a bit on the first turn putting REMEMBER THIS in tight quarters, stalked the pace and tired. LADY DEALER raced close up off the rail and tired. RAISE A GENIUS lacked speed then passed tired ones in the drive. LADY BE BOLD was fractious in the gate and was always outrun. REMEMBER THIS was in tight on the first turn, gave way and was eased.
