SILKEN MIST settled off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance nearest the rail entering the far turn, drew into striking distance while shifting outside the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and just edged that foe in time under firm encouragement. LOCK N LOLA was urged to the lead racing off the rail into the first turn, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch, resisted the winner grudgingly to the end but just failed to contain that foe. AFLEET ABACO settled out of striking distance along the inside in early stages, saved ground throughout and continued with a steady effort to improve position while earning a share. COYOTE BREEZE broke slowly, was urged to gain contention racing four wide into the first turn, steadily drew into striking distance after a half, was urged to challenge between foes racing into the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. TRIBUTE TO MOMMA settled well off the field in the opening half, swung out five wide racing into the stretch and passed some tiring foes. MYA FACCIA BELLA tracked off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, advanced to contention in tandem with the eventual winner racing through the far turn, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. SLIGO ROSE was urged to force the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, ceded that position to a rival midway through the backstretch, continued to force the issue three deep racing through the far turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. LIGHT EM UP RICH raced three wide between foes just off the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention early.
