Footnotes

SHOOT THE LOOP, bumped at the start, was reserved in hand while being guided to the rail racing to the backstretch, saved ground through the second bend while continuing under patient handling, shifted off the inside splitting foes while being roused to advance racing through the stretch, angled out four deep leaving the furlong marker but produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. PERFECTLY AT HOME worked his way to the inside early taking up a position in the second flight, split foes racing into the far turn to bid inside the pacesetter, pressed the issue inside that foe to upper stretch, edged clear approaching the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner's final bid. BRIM was settled between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled outside rivals on the far turn to challenge for command racing five wide through the stretch and continued with a mild bid in that path while gaining a share. REGGIVILLE settled three deep between foes racing in the last flight to the backstretch, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but continued with a steady effort to improve his position. BIG MAN IN BLACK, bumped at the start, was caught five wide tracking off the second flight racing into the first turn, continued with a steady advance to challenge four wide racing into the second bend but flattened out leaving midstretch. JAGUAR RIDGE, held up just out of striking distance leading the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid three deep between foes on the far turn but came up empty in the drive. IVER WITH AN E, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. CHAS THE MAN broke inwards bumping the eventual winner and BIG MAN IN BLACK, was urged to join the pace outside a rival racing well off the inside into the backstretch, continued to dispute the issue outside a rival through the second bend and emptied out nearing midstretch. HE GONE sped to the fore along the inside, disputed the issue for a half and gave way abruptly entering the second bend. GIBBY'S TORNADO tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch and dropped out racing through the far turn.
