Footnotes

CANADIAN WISH was rated between foes in the second flight maintaining striking distance in the opening half, angled to the rail entering the far turn while continuing with a steady response, came through inside foes to challenge entering upper stretch and drew clear late under pressure. JUMP TO START was held up off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out while being urged to challenge three wide racing through the far turn, couldn't match the winner's bid but continued with a grudging effort between foes to prevail for place honors. CATHYS BREEZE, forwardly placed along the inside tracking the pacesetter in the second flight, eased off the leaders while shifting off the inside racing through the far turn, shifted out four deep in upper stretch and continued with a second effort to gain some position late racing four deep to late stages. BLUEGRASS BULL was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, set the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, then weakened between foes racing through the stretch. CRYPTO GULCH, urged to contend three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued to contest the issue between foes while shifting to the inside racing into the stretch and steadily faded in the closing stages. COURTLY settled into stride just off the inside in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an even effort. TEXAS HEDGE tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn but

offered no closing bid. CINCO ESTRELLA shifted inwards to track between foes off the second flight for a half but lacked the needed late response. IKAROS, a bit slow into stride, never gained contention. SHOW YOUR FACE, restless in the gate before the start, proved no factor. TWYLAS RED CAT was a brief factor racing four deep just off the second flight in the opening stages but dropped out of contention early.
