HISNAMEISEARL was settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend, shifted out entering upper stretch gathering some momentum four wide between foes and narrowly prevailed in time in that path under pressure. BUBBA'S BIG SHOW was urged to dispute the pace four deep in the first flight in the opening quarter, continued to force the issue outside a rival while angling nearer to the inside racing into the bend, continued to dispute the issue near the inside in late stages and maintained the place honors. BELLODINI settled between foes dropping out of striking distance early, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to the end. UNCHARTEDTERRITORY, reserved last in the opening quarters, angled to the rail racing into the turn, saved ground to late stages and made some mild progress to close the gap. VALID DEVIL, reserved outside foes from well out of striking distance in the opening stages, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride too late to make an impression. LOVE YOU MON, in touch with the first flight between foes in the opening quarter, dropped off the leaders while switching to the outside racing through the turn and raced wide in the stretch while failing to rally. READY STEADY EDDY tracked the pace between foes a bit off the inside from out of striking distance racing to the turn and continued evenly to late stages. HUSH MY MOUTH, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, was urged to gain terms with the leaders three deep nearing the midway point of the turn, held a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain that momentum. HITTHELIGHTS was urged to prompt the pace along the rail in the early stages, dropped off the leaders while switching off the inside racing through the turn and steadily retreated from contention. KENTUCKY BOURBON vied briefly for the lead three deep between foes in the opening quarter and gave way abruptly leaving the turn.
