Footnotes

PACKLEN'S BID settled between foes off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening quarter, made steady progress nearing upper stretch while shifting to the rail, came through inside foes to wrest command entering upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. REDBONE, a step slow into stride, settled well off the pace, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to prove best of the others. COMMANDO KAT hopped at the start, was righted to track off the second flight outside foes racing into the turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to prevail for a share. J COOL settled near the inside in the opening stages, angled out seven wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress. NATHAN CHICAGO, urged to a forward placing four deep between foes tracking just off the pacesetter, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch but flattened out nearing the furlong marker. EVAN TEMPERED tracked off the second flight six deep in the opening quarter and never gained contention. STORMY DUDE sped clear along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch and gave way once headed by the winner. MAC'S OUTLAW worked his way to the inside early tracking well off the second flight but never gained contention. ITTY BITTY YANKEE, urged along three deep between foes chasing the pacesetter into the turn, emptied out in upper stretch. AMORLI

tracked off the first flight five wide between foes in the opening quarter but dropped out of contention early. JESUIT WARRIOR, urged between foes chasing the pacesetter into the turn, gave way in upper stretch. CUZIN DAVE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
