### Footnotes

RIO CHAMA broke readily to gain a forward placing outside foes racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to terms with a rival attending that foe's pace after a half, was roused to wrest command entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. WEALTH MANAGEMENT broke outwards bumping SOUTHERN QUIET, was settled just off the second flight near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out leaving the midway point of the far turn to split foes three deep, shifted outside foes racing into the stretch and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. LEGAL DEED settled into stride along the inside, was urged to advance leaving the far turn, then altered course nearing midstretch to split foes three deep while making some belated progress. LAFETER EVER AFTER, urged to secure a forward placing between foes, tracked the leaders leading the second flight on a narrow margin into the far turn but had no closing bid. COSMIC BREW was urged to the lead while shifting to the rail racing into the first turn, disputed the pace inside the eventual winner racing into the far turn, couldn't match that foe and gave way leaving midstretch. CHARMED N DANGEROUS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight for five furlongs and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. VIA DELOROSA tracked the leaders three wide, then four wide in the second flight for a half and steadily retreated racing into the far turn. SOUTHERN QUIET broke slowly, then was bumped, shifted out five wide racing into the backstretch and proved no threat.
