Footnotes

CUB'S THUNDER, pulling against a rating hold along the rail in the opening quarter while racing just off the first flight, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while moving to striking position, took over in that path nearing midstretch and kicked clear late under firm encouragement. A SHOT AWAY was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, duelled for command while shifting to the inside nearing upper stretch but proved only second best. TRIBECKY joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes on the turn to upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. SILKY SAMI settled well off the pace off the rail in the opening stages, swung out seven wide racing into upper stretch and improved her position with a belated effort. MICHALINA, in touch with the first flight between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the second flight to track between foes racing into the turn and continued evenly three deep between foes to late stages. COUNTRY CAUCUS was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, duelled for command racing into the turn and gave way after a half. SHARP TRIP settled outside foes dropping off the second flight racing through the

backstretch, continued four, then five wide through the turn and never gained contention. LOST ACCOUNT angled inwards in early stages to track between foes in the second flight, shifted out four wide racing through the turn while being prompted to advance but steadily faded entering upper stretch. FIRST OF FEBRUARY, reserved outside foes in the last flight early, never seriously menaced. CANDYONMYMIND never seriously menaced. CONGOTOWN, restless in the gate before the break, stumbled at the start and lost her rider. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
