Footnotes

RIME ICE broke readily, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing into the turn, edged clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady pressure. OPTIMISTIC SREVA tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside racing off the second flight, switched out in upper stretch, split foes in late stages and secured the place. MINDY MICHELLE tracked just outside the pacesetter attending that foe's pace in the opening stages, briefly pressed the issue racing through the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. LAST CORONA tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight and continued evenly racing into the stretch. SEJANO, a bit slow into stride, shifted off the inside early, angled outside foes in upper stretch making some brief progress but had no final response. DREYMORE angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders racing into the turn but was through after a half. RASPBERRY JAM tracked just off and outside the leaders, made a brief, three wide bid racing through the turn but emptied out early.
