Footnotes

ARRESTED BY DUFFY broke inwards, was collected to track just off the leaders along the rail racing into the backstretch, came through when presented an opening in upper stretch to challenge, wrested command and held sway to the end under pressure. ANGEL COOKIE was settled off the second flight in early stages, made steady progress inside foes on the far turn, followed the winner's path entering upper stretch, shifted outside the leader to challenge in the last furlong but proved only second best. MOONLIT ROAD, reserved off the second flight while shifting off the inside in the opening stages, angled five wide after a half, angled back to the inside on the far turn, switched out to split foes four wide in upper stretch and improved her position to the end. STRETCHIN GRETCHEN, caught four wide racing into the first turn, angled inside entering the backstretch while dropping out of contention, saved ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress late. SHE'S NO BULL, a bit unruly in the gate before the start, was urged to a forward placing, tracked just outside the pacesetter in the backstretch, pressed that foe racing through the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. SEAQUIN STAR was urged to the lead inside foes, dictated the pace into the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch and gave way. VIA DI ROMA tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and soon faded in the drive. MOJITO TIME tracked the leaders three wide in second flight, made a brief bid in that path on the far turn but quickly emptied out. LOVELEIGH, caught four wide racing through the first turn, tracked off and outside the second flight to the far turn and steadily retreated. JO'S FINALE shifted outside foes racing into the backstretch and was soon outpaced.
