Footnotes

BAG TOSSER broke outwards bumping SHOPPING CART, was quickly collected to gain terms with a rival on the pace, pressed that foe racing into the bend, forged clear in upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure to maintain her advantage. CORNER GIRL, bumped at the start by DANCING EURO, quickly recovered, was reserved between foes stalking just off the first flight, came out to challenge three deep entering upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with the winner. DANCING EURO broke outwards bumping CORNER GIRL, was collected off that foe to track the leaders near the inside, angled out a bit in upper stretch but had no final bid while continuing well enough to earn a share. HOT KITTEN was settled well off the pace along the inside, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch, gained some position late but made no real impression. SHOPPING CART hopped in the air, then was bumped at the start, tracked the leaders outside foes as part of the second flight, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. ROYAL GAMBLE sped to the fore along the inside, disputed the lead inside a rival racing through the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
