**Footnotes**

FOXIE'S BOY sped to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing into the bend and held sway to the end under steady pressure. PUBLISH tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the turn, switched off the rail exchanging some contact with E T GO leaving the furlong marker but continued with interest to close the gap. DEMIGOD, held up out of striking distance along the inside racing to the turn, shifted out seven wide racing through the stretch and made some belated progress to earn a share. TIDY UP tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside, made steady progress while angling out four wide leaving the furlong marker and continued willingly to finish on even terms with a rival for fourth. BETTER MAKE MONEY settled outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid between foes to finish on even terms with a rival for fourth. E T GO angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, was bumped leaving the furlong marker and gave way when failing to gain terms with the winner. CORRUPT angled to the inside to track just off the second flight racing into the turn but

offered no rally. DEVIL ME NOT tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight but couldn't produce the needed closing response. KEYSTONE KID never seriously menaced. BANK ACCOUNT tracked outside foes in the second flight, drifted out racing through the turn and steadily faded from contention.
