Footnotes

SIN BIN, bumped and caught in tight quarters at the start, was reserved out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, made steady progress leaving the far turn to split foes near the inside, came through close quarters leaving the sixteenth marker and just edged IROQUOIS MISS under steady handling. The latter angled inwards gaining a forward placing racing into the first turn, was pulling a bit between foes while attending the pace under rating, inherited the lead on the second bend, went briefly clear nearing midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner late. MADALIN NICOLE was held up between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap and gain a share. DEL BONITA, reserved along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress inside foes late. SPECIAL

VICTORY tracked off the second flight under some reserve in the opening half, split foes three wide leaving the second bend, shifted out racing through the stretch and continued with some interest. ADELIA, forwardly placed three wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into upper stretch and gave way. PHALEONOPSIS, bumped, then held up out of tight quarters at the start, continued under reserve racing well off the inside to upper stretch, then shifted inwards improving her position while racing in some traffic through midstretch. ORCHARD tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes while off the second flight in the opening half, was caught four wide racing through the far turn while making a brief bid but quickly came up empty in upper stretch. FANDEMONIUM settled outside foes in the opening half, was caught five wide leaving the far turn and had no further response. AFFECTION tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening half, made a brief bid from that position on the far turn but quickly retreated in upper stretch. A. J.'S BEAUTY tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted off the inside entering the far turn and dropped out in upper stretch. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER flashed brief pace inside foes racing into the backstretch but gave way after a half.
