Footnotes

LEMONDROPSPRITZER, never far from striking distance, attended the pace six deep in the opening stages, shifted in nearing the turn while readily advancing on the pacesetter, moved to command midway through the turn and maintained a clear margin to the end under firm encouragement while racing well off the inside. BLARNEY D'OR settled off the leaders while angling to the inside early, shifted out nearing the turn, was urged to split foes then shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prove best of the others. SANTO RIO broke a step slowly, settled into stride along the rail, saved ground in last through the turn, shifted out nearing midstretch and continued with a belated effort to improve her position. COURTESY CALL tracked the leaders between foes just off the second flight, was urged to advance three deep on the bend, was carried out nearing upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. GRACEN RACEN, bumped at the start, was righted to track between foes off the second flight racing into the turn and continued evenly to late stages. BARI'S PULPETTE settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. HOORAY FOR YALEI was urged to gain a forward placing along the inside and came up empty after a half. MARKREE BREEZE tracked the pace racing four wide to the turn and never gained contention. WIN FRIENDLY tracked the leaders along the inside behind the second flight early, was steadied a bit avoiding tight quarters racing into the turn and soon gave way. PRETTY PERCEPTIVE, off a step slowly, was hustled to the lead five deep between foes in the opening stages, shifted to the inside once clear, lost the lead after three furlongs, drifted out nearing the quarter mile marker impeding COURTESY CALL and gave way abruptly.
