Footnotes

DAKOTA'S COURT shifted inwards in the opening stages taking up a position between foes in the second flight, was urged to split foes challenging for command four deep between rivals midway through the turn, gained a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and extended the margin under pressure. GLOBAL ALLIANCE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, shifted out entering the turn to advance between foes, shifted three deep splitting foes racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. LAKOTA WOLF was urged to dispute the pace three deep between foes from the break, pressed the issue between foes to upper stretch and weakened in late stages while losing second. GARLAND'S SPIRIT was urged to dispute the pace between foes a bit off the inside in the opening stages, shifted to the rail entering the turn while continuing to force the issue inside foes but weakened leaving the furlong marker. AUGUST DAY tracked off the first flight five wide racing into the turn turn, then continued evenly in that path to late stages. SACRED RANGE, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, swung seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. IOLANDA'S PERFECT, reserved in last while guided nearer to the inside in the opening stages, never gained striking distance. DEVILS TOWER broke slowly, settled outside foes, was fanned eight wide into the stretch and proved no factor. LONGER VERSION, held up between foes in close quarters in the opening stages, angled out six wide racing into the stretch but had no rally. VAN DEMON joined the pace four wide in the opening stages, drifted out five wide racing through the turn and soon gave way. B TWO SPECIAL, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening quarter, dropped out early.
