Q. P. CAT sprinted to a long early lead, set the pace while clear and responded to urging in the stretch to hold COME SEPTEMBER safe at the finish. COME SEPTEMBER stalked the pace of the winner, moved closer on the second turn, challenged in the stretch but could not get by the top one. SHE'S A DRUMMER raced in good position off the rail but could not respond to urging with a willing bid. ROYAL BANDITA raced near the middle of the pack but never reached contention. OUT OF OPTIONS lacked speed and made a mild bid in the stretch and flattened out. LU KEEL raced near the middle of the field and gave way in the drive. SENORITA CZARINA was never a factor. ROCKY'S RED GLARE was always outrun. BUGSY MAE was never close.
