Footnotes

CHAMPION KID joined the pace between foes soon after the start, forced the issue outside a rival entering the bend, edged forward to a narrow advantage in upper stretch and was roused clear late. BE BRAVE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance racing under some reserve while well off the inside in the opening quarter, angled inwards entering the bend while moving into striking distance, shifted out in upper stretch to challenge five wide, then edged a rival for place honors in the final stages and was taken in hand once the issue was decided. BRAIN TEAZE ducked inwards at the start, was righted to track the leaders as part of the second flight, continued with interest along the inside racing through the bend, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes nearing the furlong marker, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was just collared for the place. BRAVE YANK, prominent four wide in the opening stages, made a steady progress in that path to challenge racing into upper stretch but was outfinished in the last furlong. JUSTA AVERAGE JOE, a step slow into stride, tracked the leaders along the rail from well out of striking distance, shifted out in upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. JOSHUA JET FUEL was urged to dispute the pace racing three deep between foes from the outset, continued to dispute the issue into upper stretch and gave way late. GRASS AFFAIR was hustled to join the pace along the rail from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. GO POSSE GO exchanged some contact with HAILFELLOW at the start, was collected to track the pace between foes racing well out of striking distance and lacked the needed closing response. MAGIC MAN broke slowly, was reserved along the inside early and never seriously menaced. HAILFELLOW

exchanged bumps with GO POSSE GO and was shuffled out of tight quarters at the start, never gained contention. LOST SECRET was never a factor.
