ANEWPAIROFSHOES broke outwards brushing ANNIE'S YANK, was collected off that foe to track off the second flight outside foes unhurried racing to the turn, steadily moved to striking position while shifting out four wide entering upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and drew well clear under firm encouragement. SONG OF MY HEART moved to the fore soon after the break, dictated the pace racing into the bend while a bit off the inside, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held place honors while shifting out late. NOT REPENTFUL, reserved in last racing off the inside in the opening quarter, came around foes nearing upper stretch, angled out five wide and produced a steady late response to just miss second. START STREET, on terms with the pacesetter in the opening stages, stalked that foe along the inside, was steadied a bit approaching the turn, came through when presented an opening to challenge entering upper stretch but flattened out late. HOLY CLASSIC settled off the second flight near the inside in early stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch and improved her position three deep between foes. ANNIE'SYANK, carried outwards a bit at the start, was urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight tracking the leader racing to the bend, made a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly came up empty. JALOUX angled inside tracking the leaders just behind the second flight and steadily faded after a half.
