Footnotes

CODEWORD (IRE) shifted nearer to the inside early gaining a position just off the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, continued in that position under light rating to the far turn, was urged to challenge inside the leader entering upper stretch, altered course approaching the furlong marker avoiding tight quarters and produced a steady late response to just edge ULTIMATE X. in time under firm encouragement. The latter moved to the fore on his own courage racing into the backstretch, dictated a comfortable pace on a narrow margin along the inside to the far turn, was roused to repel the winner's challenge in upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker and contested the issue grudgingly to the end while coming up second best. MY SONNY BOY, reserved off the second flight along the inside, made a steady advance to contention along the rail nearing upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap on the top pair while bidding between those foes in the closing stages. PEYTONVILLE shifted in early to track the pace between foes just off the second flight, shifted on the backstretch to race three deep between foes, angled out four wide splitting foes racing through the stretch but made some effort to gain position late. BLUEGRASS JET settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, dropped into last along the inside entering the far turn, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress late. HAPMAN tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight

racing to the backstretch, advanced to lodge a brief, three wide bid entering the far turn but flattened out racing into upper stretch. HOODLUM settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance while shifting out five deep nearing upper stretch but proved empty in the drive. MING GLO broke slowly, was guided to the inside early, shifted out on the far turn but never gained contention. DANDYMAN, urged to gain a forward placing just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, prompted the pace between foes racing into the second bend but quickly emptied out. MYSTIC tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half but retreated from contention early.
