Footnotes

GOOD CHEMISTRY shifted off the inside leading the second flight on a narrow margin into the backstretch tracking the pacesetter under light rating in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command midway through the far turn, drew clear racing into upper stretch and held SKY BLUE MONGOLIA safe to the end under firm handling. The latter was urged to gain a forward placing racing three deep just off the eventual winner, continued with an even effort in that path into upper stretch, then found his best stride late to close the gap while only second best. ITALIAN BREEZE broke sharply, dictated the pace racing a bit off the rail into the second bend and gave way racing into upper stretch when proving no match for the winner. BOSS ALLEY settled into stride off the second flight early, made some brief progress between foes racing into the far turn to gain contention but had no final kick. DEFIANT FLYER settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out racing through the far turn but never seriously menaced. CHILACA tracked just off the second flight near the inside in the opening half and steadily faded racing into the far turn. WARBLIRD broke slowly, was urged to contend four wide racing into the first turn but retreated from contention early.
