Footnotes

BLUE LASER was settled in hand along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily gathered momentum while switching outside foes racing through the far turn, swung five wide entering upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure but produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. DUKE OF RUTHERFORD was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing into the first turn, forged clear racing into the second bend, held sway on a commanding margin racing into upper stretch but faltered leaving the furlong marker. OKLAHOMA HERO broke slowly, settled into stride, split foes three deep racing through the far turn while caught in some tight quarters midway through the second bend, shifted to the inside in upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to improve position. FLYINGWITHTHEBEAT, caught eight deep racing to the first turn while being prompted to contend, dropped off the pace while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid between foes racing into the far turn but soon flattened

out. THAW urged to contend four wide between foes racing into the first turn, chased the pacesetter into the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. SHINE THE ROCKET, caught seven deep between foes while under pressure to gain terms with the leaders racing into the first turn, dropped off the pace to track outside foes racing to the far turn but had no closing bid. TRAGIC MAGIC settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. BINGORUN, urged to terms with the first flight racing five wide between foes into the first turn, retreated from contention early. GRANDPA GIBBY settled into stride along the inside, was steadied, then shuffled back avoiding a tiring foe leaving the half mile marker and never menaced thereafter. NEWS BULLETIN was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the backstretch, couldn't match the pacesetter after a half and steadily faded racing through the far turn. DEAL OF A LIFETIME vied briefly between foes but dropped out early. EXOTIC WILDCAT, caught six wide between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the pace to race between foes to the second bend and dropped out nearing upper stretch.
