PA'S PRINCESS MI saved ground and showed little. NICE KIPPER raced near the middle of the field and weakened. LITTLE WHITE LIE was bumped and squeezed at the start and was always outrun. LOOKATTHOSELEGS was also outrun. MY MUG SHOT gave way in the drive.
