DIAMOND NIC set the pace from off the rail and held sway in the drive. NEVER WAS raced three wide near the middle of the field and rallied in the stretch but missed. HEISPRETTY CLASSI raced inside, angled out and gained belatedly for a share. BOB'S JOHN BOY raced close up inside and lacked a rally. ROCHESTER CAT raced close up off the rail and weakened. SOUTHERN VISION was squeezed back at the start, raced off the rail and was not a factor. OUST was unruly in the post parade, raced near the middle of the field and gave way. BOLD STANDARD raced close up off the rail and tired. ITSNOTLUCK was bumped at the start and was always outrun. MICHALSON was off slowly, made a bid on the turn but faltered. DOUBLE MARCH trailed throughout.
