**Footnotes**

AKA LILY'S LAD moved to the fore inside foes racing into the first turn, set the pace into the backstretch while pulling a bit under light rating, continued to dictate terms on a narrow margin into the second bend, turned back a challenge leaving the far turn and drew clear racing through the stretch while being kept to steady pressure. MAGIC BULLET, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, eased off the top pair to track those foes outside a rival after the opening half, angled three wide nearing upper stretch to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but continued with interest to prevail for place honors late. SUMMER'S EMPIRE, never far back, pulled his way to contention while drifting out a bit racing into the backstretch, angled in to force the pace outside the winner racing into the far turn, couldn't keep pace with that rival and weakened late to lose place honors. LEMON CUSTARD, allowed to settle off the inside in the opening half, angled to the rail nearing the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. OUGHTA BE MINE reserved along the inside racing just off the leaders racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SWEETEST RHYTHM, reserved three wide in second flight racing to the far turn, steadily faded from contention in upper stretch. HOOCHED EXPRESS tracked the leaders between foes in the flight for six furlongs but lacked the needed late response.
